
# Lifecycle of a Student

- Planning
  - initial contact through orientation and registration
- Preparation
  - orientation and registration through week of welcome/move-in
- Momentum Year
  - matriculation and Year 1 through first summer
- Full Momentum
  - returning to college for year 2 through graduation and beyond
